



Terms and Conditions of Senior Membership

- All members must take responsibility to ensure that they are up to date with the Laws of Cricket, understand and adhere to them.
- All members must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of age, gender, ability, race, cultural background, religious beliefs or sexual identity.
- Members should recognise the valuable contribution made by coaches and officials who are usually volunteers; they give their time and resources to provide cricket for you.
- All members must respect officials and publicly accept their decisions.
- All members should be a positive role model by treating other players and officials with the same level of respect they would expect to be shown.
- Members should use correct and proper language at all times.
- Members should only drink alcohol in moderation on club premises or whilst representing the club.
- Members must not consume drugs on club premises or whilst representing the club.
- Members should keep to agreed timings for training and matches or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late.
- Members must wear suitable kit for training and match sessions, as agreed with the coach/team manager/captain.
- Members must pay membership or training fees promptly.
- Bullying of any sort will not be tolerated. Encourage everyone to enjoy sport and understand that people have different motivations for taking part.
- Matches will occasionally be videoed and broadcast. If you would prefer not to be filmed, please inform your team captain.
